

## What Exactly is Available in Hoven for Medical Services?

With the many changes to our small town health care, you may be asking yourself, what exactly are my options? How will we get our needs met? Can we continue to live rurally and still have the life we want to if medical issues come up? There may be more available for you and your family than you once thought. South Dakota Public Health Services, offered through our local County Health Clinic, provides medical help to those in rural areas. The rural medical needs of Potter County, Walworth County and Edmunds County are serviced through the Public Health office located at the Bowdle Healthcare Center, in Bowdle SD.

Listed below are the County Health Nurse services provided to the Hoven Area:

**Home Health:** Services such as assistance setting up medications, blood draws for lab work, and home visits. These services are paid through private pay or by the Department of Social Services if the patient qualifies. If the patient is a veteran, the VA will contract with Bowdle Healthcare center to provide services. Lab draws are most often utilized by the elderly that are unable to drive.

**Homemaker Services:** Services such as help with bathing, cleaning, cooking, laundry, errands and everyday household tasks. These services are also paid through private pay or by the Department of Social Services if the patient qualifies.

**Alert Phones:** At the touch of a button, your loved one can contact emergency service (if necessary) or a trusted caregiver to help them. Thoughtful care is immediate with FirstCall's® Cooperative Response Center. When an emergency arises, a simple touch to the button on either a receiver or wireless transmitter instantly connects your loved one to a professional central station operator (CSO) who will quickly assess their needs and send the appropriate help for them. The County Health office is available to help set this service up as needed. It is provided by the Department of Social Services or by Prairie Innovations out of Aberdeen.

For Skilled Nursing care, many of the services are not available to our area due to Medicare regulations. In the event that skilled nursing care services are needed, the Hospital Nurse Educators, where your care is being provided, may be able to teach family members caring for the patient, those skills needed to keep them at home and independent as possible.

Keep in mind that outreach services are available at most clinics/hospitals, so if you are receiving care at any of the surrounding HealthCare centers, they would be able to assist you with any needs or questions if your circumstances are outside of the Public Health Care realm.
